

# HELLO FROM ME

<b>Name of Lesson:</b>	Leaving Home 008	<b>LEVEL:</b>	8
<b>What you will need:</b>

**OBJECTIVE:**

To examine emotions and feelings when saying goodbye to someone before leaving on a long journey.

**PART ONE**

Ask the class what they think they would feel like to say goodbye to someone special just before you leave on a long journey. Develop vocabulary and invite students to write each word on the board.

Listen to the audio.

**PART TWO**

Have the students ever experienced that feeling – the feeling of gas building up in their throat just as they say goodbye, and not wanting to look at anyone in the eye. Do you feel the same way if you are going away on a short trip? Does anyone have any advice about what to do? Invite students to read aloud to the class the same para students heard in the audio. Focus on pacing. This is not a section of the book you can read too quickly.

**PART THREE**

Using slides 3, 4, 5, and 6 of the PPT, look at each of the characters from the story. How would they feel saying goodbye to Tim?

Mum: Of course, mum will be sad, but the trip to England was her idea.

Cherry: Does Cherry really care? What is she really thinking as she says goodbye?

Lollipop: Does a pet dog know that someone is leaving? Does the dog feel sad?

Uncle Tam: Read the final paragraph on page 10 to the students. Discuss it with them.

Maybe Uncle Tam feels the saddest of them all? What do the students think?

**PART FOUR**
